

The Relief Fund provides financial assistance to Sport Clips Team Members and Team Leaders when tragedy strikes.

What types of events does the Relief Fund cover?

- Serious illness or injury resulting in medical bills and lost wages up to \$10,000
- Loss of or severe damage to automobile resulting in financial hardship up to \$5,000
- Loss of or severe damage to housing resulting in financial hardship up to \$10,000
- Other unexpected catastrophic events up to \$10,000
- Death of immediate family member up to \$15,000 (up to \$5,000 for the death of a parent)

What are the restrictions or requirements?

- Applicant must upload documentation for all expenses or lost wages.
- Team Leader recommendation for Relief Fund payment required.
- Application must be filed within two years of the qualifying event.
- Team member typically must have been employed for three months prior to the qualifying event.
- Maximum \$25,000 relief payments paid to one individual/family within a 12-month period.

What types of events are NOT covered by the Relief Fund?

- Standard car and home repairs/maintenance
- · Minor illnesses (colds, flu, and COVID)
- · Divorce/legal fees
- · Maternity leave (unless there is a serious medical issue with the mother or baby)
- · Lost wages from other jobs or for other family members
- · Events covered by lawsuits. Go Fund Me. or other financial assistance

What if I have a situation that is not listed here?

You should apply so the committee can decide if your situation qualifies.

How do I apply?

Scan the QR code to go directly to the online application. You will need to answer all questions, including your Team Leader/Owner information. If you need to collect information or documentation, you can save your application and resume it later. Please do not submit an incomplete application.

How long will it take to get approved?

It typically takes 2 to 4 weeks from submitting your application to receiving a payment.

How will I receive payment?

The Foundation will send a check to the address on your application.
